

Feature Article: How Australian SMBs (small and medium sized businesses) are performing post-pandemic

The worst of the COVID-19 pandemic is behind us, but many retailers remain in a state of disruption.

The end of restrictions and border closures saw a surge in retail activity and consumer spending. However, global conflicts and economic uncertainty are having lasting impacts on small businesses. Despite these challenges, there is opportunity.



Retailers are focused on bouncing back, and small and medium-sized businesses (SMBs) have demonstrated incredible resilience

And with online spending continuing to grow, omnichannel retailing offers a strong path forward for sustainable growth.

Mastercard has released a new report identifying the top issues facing Australian SMBs and the report reveals:

- SMB formations have seen a resurgence at each easing of restrictions, whilst closures have stabilised back to pre-COVID-19 levels for 2022.
- Whilst online spending grew for SMBs, the overall share of spend remained stable, reinforcing the importance of longerterm views on customer channels.
- New SMBs have taken a more risk-averse approach and are increasingly focusing on a single distribution channel optimising their execution before any extension into an omnichannel approach.
- SMBs across all industries were adversely affected by fluctuations in spend, but the adoption and use of delivery partners means that spend may be understated, particularly for eating places and groceries, as this spend will have been attributed through a third-party channel.

The Minister for Small and Family Business, the Hon. Andrea Michaels MP recently launched South Australia's Small Business Strategy 2023-2030, which is designed to support small businesses to adapt, grow and succeed, through initiatives like the Small Business Fundamentals Program (SBFP).

It is with great pride that the City of Salisbury can announce that the Polaris Business Development Centre have been successful with their application for funding, in the amount of \$250,0000 over the next two years through the SBFP.

"I'm so incredibly happy that the Polaris Business Development Centre were successful in receiving this grant. They do such wonderful work, helping our local small businesses to thrive and reach their full potential. Small Business is the backbone of our economy and I am excited to see what can be achieved for our community with the extra funding," said Mayor Gillian Aldridge OAM.

Minister Michaels said "the small business community told us their biggest challenges are a lack of time and resources to focus on strategy or growth as well as cashflow and lack of access to capital, attracting and retaining staff, digital literacy and other foundational skills."

The SBFP responds directly to these challenges, providing the tools and tailored support for small and family businesses to build their business know-how and capability in areas critical to long-term sustainability/growth.

Polaris Business Development Centre is the hub for business and entrepreneurship in Northern Adelaide, is supported with core funding from the City of Salisbury, and has provided support to thousands of businesses in our community since its formation in 2001.

Safe Work Month October 2023 Host a Safe Tea Chat

This is a great opportunity to chat with your staff about the importance of workplace health and safety, the need to report unsafe work conditions or work practices and to keep a check on employee's wellbeing.



Replace the Waste Single Use Plastics Ban

South Australia's Single-use and Other Plastic Products (Waste Avoidance) Act 2020 is the first legislation of its kind in Australia.



The State Government has introduced a phased and manageable move away from single-use plastics enabling all South Australians to replace waste by avoiding single-use

plastics and adopting 'clean and green' alternatives.

Banned from September 2023

Plastic-stemmed cotton buds will be phased out. Exemptions are in place, where plasticstemmed cotton buds are required for medical, scientific, forensic or law enforcement purposes only.

Single-use plastic bowls and plates will be phased out. A temporary exemption is in place for single-use cardboard or fibreboard bowls and plates that are lined with or coated with plastic.

Plastic pizza savers will be phased out.

A list of other items will be phased out in 2024.

SCC Business Watch ... Business Security Tips



Salisbury

Business owners and employees can play an important role in preventing and reducing the risk of crime occurring in the work place, and there are a number of practical, proactive measures that

can be taken to avoid becoming a victim of crime.

Here are some tips to consider:

- Make sure laneways, car parks and other external areas are well lit
- Prune trees and shrubs to ensure clear visibility of the property and reduce the likelihood opportunities for a burglar to hide
- All boundary gates/fences should be well built and maintained, adequately secured, clear of rubbish and free from objects that can be put against them to climb over
- External doors should be solid, and all external doors and windows fully secured with quality and regularly maintained locks
- If padlocks are used on gates or doors, make sure they are of an appropriate and recommended standard
- Installing bollards, heavy planters or large rocks can act as a barrier to ram raids
- Install a monitored alarm system, mirrors, CCTV or perpetrator marking technology and prominently display signs warning about the presence of any security measures
- Advertising material and posters on windows and doors, and other window coverings, should be kept at a minimum to provide a clear view of the business from inside & out
- Safes should be securely fixed to a floor, wall or similar solid object
- All property should be clearly and permanently marked with the name of your business or the Australian Business Number (ABN).
- Retrieve keys and access cards from exemployees
- Never leave large amounts of cash on premises overnight
- Make sure all staff adheres to lock-up procedures
