Developing your business plan

Before taking advantage of the free templates to help you write a detailed business plan, here are some tips about what to consider before you start.

1. Determine your plan's objectives

Are there multiple purposes for your business plan? Will it be used internally or shared externally, such as with potential investors or banks? Identifying the purpose will help you tailor the contents for the right audience.

2. Organise your financials

If you're seeking financing, lenders and investors will evaluate your financial position and stability. They'll want to know about your current available funds, the required capital and your projected revenue. If you're just starting out and lack financial information, writing a business plan based on a guide or template will help you prepare your finances.

Craft your summary as the final step Summarise the key points of your business plan, capturing essential details. Strive to be informative yet succinct, highlighting aspects such as your business purpose, target market, goals, and unique selling points. This is an opportunity to showcase your business or idea. Avoid exaggerating your position.

4. Seek assistance:

Don't procrastinate and set aside time to research and prepare. If you get stuck or are unsure of how to continue, get advice from a third party to help. Numerous government services are available to support your business planning and offer general advice, workshops, seminars, networking events, and can even connect you with a mentor or business coach such as the **Business Fundamentals Program**.

5. Regularly evaluate your plan

As your business evolves, your plan must adapt to ensure you stay on the right track. Keeping your plan up to date enables you to maintain focus on your objectives. It's advisable to maintain a record of each version of your business plan.

6. Safeguard your plan

For certain businesses, simply identifying or marking your plan as 'confidential' is enough of a protection. However, if you use innovative practices, products or services, you may want individuals (including your bank) to sign a confidentiality agreement to safeguard your intellectual property. Including a request within the plan, asking readers not to disclose its contents, is a sensible move.

This campaign, now in its 4th year, is designed to get more customers through your doors and enjoying your food and hospitality during Winter.



These Grants support the work of local community organisations by enabling the inclusion of vulnerable people and providing supports to increase participation in volunteering.

Expressions of Interest are now open for the Families and Communities Program 2023 - 24 Volunteer Grants

Grants of between \$1,000 and \$5,000 are available to help community organisations to support the efforts of volunteers.

Grants are only available for items that directly benefit the work of volunteers.

Volunteer Grants can be used to:

- buy small equipment for volunteers
- reimburse volunteers for fuel, transport or training costs
- fund promotional activities to increase awareness and participation in volunteering opportunities.

SCC Business Watch ... Prevent Laptop and Tablet Theft

With many of us being more mobile during our work day including working offsite in cafes, etc. it is a timely reminder to look after your laptop, tablet and mobile phone.

Laptop computers and tablets are a popular target for thieves. These devices are valuable and information stored such as your personal details and banking information may also be compromised by a theft.

To prevent becoming a victim of theft, consider the following crime prevention security tips.

- Record the manufacturer, model, and serial number and file this information in a safe place.
- Consider using an alternative bag to transport your laptop/tablet.
- Attach a security cable to the universal security slot (USS) and secure to a fixed object where possible.
- Engrave your driver's licence number prefixed by the letter 'S' for South Australia.
- Remove and safely store dongles/external hard drives.
- When at home, store the laptop/tablet in a secure location.
- Never leave your laptop/tablet visible in your vehicle.
- Always take the laptop/tablet as hand luggage when travelling and when placing it through airport security, maintain constant observation.
- Set a login password, using a secure password, sufficiently cryptic and not easy to guess.



Many electronic devices now have the capability of being tracked should they be lost or stolen. E.g. using the "Find my iPhone" apyou can track an iPad. If you have any questions please contact your local police station or visit www.police.sa.gov.au
